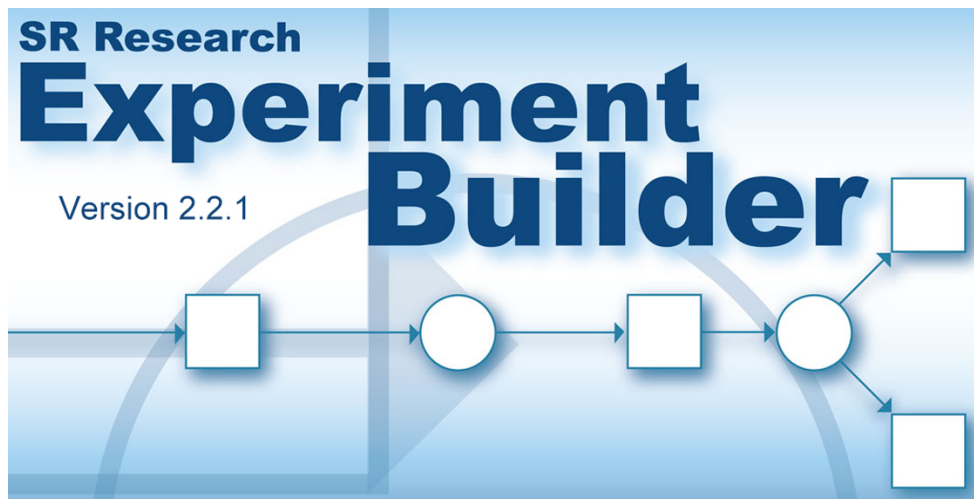

Experiment Builder 2.2.1 Released



Experiment Builder 2.2.1 includes support for biometric device integration with new examples and added support for Philips-EGI, Brain Products, Neuroscan, and Biosemi systems. There is also support for generic serial port devices, a new blink trigger and more. As always, all our Experiment Builder and Data Viewer updates come at no cost for existing software users.
