EyeLink Display Software Update




















The EyeLink Display Software (also known as the EyeLink DevKit / EyeLink Display API) enables other programming languages and stimulus presentation software to communicate with the EyeLink Host PC. The latest release, Version 2.1.1, is the result of a considerable effort on behalf of our programmers and support team. The new version is backward compatible and includes optimizations for recent versions of Windows, macOS, and Linux. New example templates are included for Psychtoolbox, E-Prime, Presentation, PsychoPy, OpenSesame, and more. The example templates are highly commented and illustrate a wide range of integration techniques, including implementing gaze-contingent tasks. We recommend that anyone using third-party stimulus presentation software downloads and installs v2.1.1. New "Getting Started Guides" on the support forum provide detailed instructions for all supported stimulus presentation solutions.
